He worked among the Muslims in the Philippines and is most famous for originating the learn to read movement called "Each One Teach One." It is estimated that over 60 million people have learned to read in their own language because of this movement. He later founded Laubach Literacy that still helps 150,000 people in America learn to read each year.

Even though I was a literacy volunteer for many years and I truly appreciate his accomplishments in that area, I learned about Frank Laubach from a spiritual director who recommended a book he wrote about praying constantly. Laubach is consider a modern-day mystic because he spent his life in an attitude of constant prayer. He credits all of his accomplishments to God.

I have heard many of you say that you wished, or hoped or even prayed that our church would grow again. I also know that many of you actively invite others to church and I know that the people you ask are blessed because of the invitation whether they come or not. I believe that if we all strive to follow Frank Laubach's model and each of us ask someone to come to worship and then pray for them, the people we ask will be blessed and so will our community.

I struggled a little bit ordering my German meal when a man at the table next to me turned and let me know that if I could finish that order, I'd be speaking Bavarian by the end.


I laughed and he asked where we were from. Colorado.


